RE : Guidelines on weather-related suspension of classes during remote learning

In the light of the remote learning arrangement in the University, the following guidelines on weather-related suspension of classes are issued. These guidelines will apply wherever the students are residing.

- 1) **Storm signal number 1:** No suspension of classes although the faculty is asked to shorten synchronous sessions.
- 2) **Storm signal number 2:** Suspension of online synchronous classes due to internet connectivity issues and/or interruptions in power and telecommunication services caused by the typhoon/bad weather conditions.
- 3) **Storm signal number 3 and above:** Suspension of both asynchronous and synchronous classes due to internet connectivity issues and/or interruptions in power and telecommunication services caused by the typhoon/bad weather conditions.

The faculty is enjoined to exercise utmost leniency and flexibility, especially to students in affected areas, by postponing/extending submission deadlines of class requirements/assignments.
