Re: UP LIBRARY AMNESTY PROGRAM

UP is launching a Library Amnesty Program in celebration of the University Library Centennial. All University Libraries and College/Unit Libraries in the UP System will be implementing this Program from **18 April to 29 April 2022.**

Below are the guidelines for accepting returns of overdue library materials:

- 1. Fines for all overdue books returned during the 18-29 April 2022 period shall be waived.
- 2. All users (students, faculty, staff) with overdue books in any library within the UP System are covered by the amnesty.
- 3. The amnesty only covers overdue books that have been returned in good condition. Lost and damaged books are not covered.
- 4. Reproduction or photocopies will not be accepted in place of damaged or lost books.
- 5. The library reserves the right to evaluate the acceptability of returned overdue books.
- 6. Reserve Books borrowed during this period are not covered in the Library Amnesty Program.
