If there is an **Explosion**:

- 1 Take cover under sturdy furniture, or leave the building if directed to do so by emergency responders.
- **2** Stay away from windows.
- 3 Do not light matches.
- 4 Move well away from the site of the hazard to a safe location.
- 5 Only use stairs
- 6 Call your Building Marshall or Communication Officer and the UP PGH Police at 5548400 local 2552 -2551

REMEMBER:

PREPARATION IS KEY.

Take every step necessary to meet the threat.

Bomb jokes or false bomb threat is a violation of Presidential Decree 1727 punishable with Five (5) years imprisonment or PHP 40,000 fine, or both.

If You Receive a **Bomb Threat:**

- Stay calm and keep your voice calm.
- Pay close attention to details. Talk to the caller to obtain as much information as possible.
- **3** Take notes. Ten Things to ask:





- ⚠ Observe the caller's:
 - Speech patterns (accent, tone)
 - Emotional state (angry, agitated, calm, etc.)
 - Background noise (traffic, people talking and accents, music and type, etc.)
 - · Age and gender
- Write down other data:
 - Date and time of call
 - How threat was received (letter, note, telephone)
- 6 Call your Building Marshall or Communication Officer and the UP PGH Police at 5548400 local 2552 2551 and submit your notes from the telephone call or the bomb threat (letter or note) to them.

In Any Bomb Threat Situation:

- Check your work area for unfamiliar items.
- Do not touch suspicious items.
- Take personal belongings when you leave.
- · Leave doors and windows open.
- Do not turn light switches on or off.
- · Only use stairs.
- Do not use elevators.
